San José, Calif. – [American Airlines](#) is expanding destination options in spring with the addition of twice-daily nonstop service between [Mineta San Jose International Airport](#) (SJC) and [Austin-Bergstrom International Airport](#). The flights will offer an important connection between Silicon Valley and Silicon Hills when they begin operating on April 7, 2020. Flights are available for purchase beginning Dec. 16, 2019.
