#### **KEY DEFINITIONS**



- ACDBE-Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise
- Enplaning Passenger (Epax)- Someone who boards an aircraft-not someone exiting an aircraft/arriving at SJC.
- Sales per Enplanement (SPE or SEP)-The average (not actual) amount spent by each
  passenger who boards an aircraft (sales/total enplanements); it is NOT the same as a
  check average.
- Prime Operator A company that runs multiple retail stores or restaurants at an airport.

  They may operate all stores themselves, sublease one or more stores to other operators and/or partner in one or more joint venture(s).

## The following are Concession Concepts All concepts offer opportunities for local businesses to participate

- Specialty Retail: Nationally or locally branded stores that feature specific brands (i.e., Nike, M.A.C., Tumi) or products (i.e., Sports Merchandise, See's). These stores are frequently found at street locations and airports.
- <u>Travel Essentials:</u> Offer convenience items (candy, snacks, bottled beverages, health and beauty aids, souvenirs, etc.). Items can be purchased quickly and efficiently.
- <u>Café:</u> Specialty coffee, pastries, and Grab & Go offerings as well as basic travel essentials merchandise.



#### **KEY DEFINITIONS**



#### All concepts offer opportunities for local businesses to participate

- Hybrid Retail: Stores offer merchandise from both specialty retail, travel essentials, and/or café's. Specialty retail in hybrid stores include local merchandise
- Grab & Go: Food and beverage items such as pre-packaged sandwiches and salads or other items that are either shelf stable or held in coolers.




#### RETAIL RFP



#### Request for Proposal (RFP) scheduled to be released in August 2024

- ☐ 2 packages, each consisting of:
  - ☐ 6 retail in-line concession locations with a mix of travel essentials and specialty retail
  - ☐ Approximately 6,700 square feet
  - ☐ Minimum Capital Expenditure: \$800 per square foot
- ☐ Term: 12 Years, starting July 01, 2025
  - ☐ Phased turnover of concession locations July 01, 2025, and July 01, 2026



# Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Program



#### Purpose of the ACDBE Program

The ACDBE program was created to minimize concerns related to historical problems with minority discrimination in the award and administration of concession opportunities at airports.

- Create a level playing field
- Help remove barriers

Adherence to ACDBE program regulations is required for an airport to remain eligible to receive federal grants for airport development from the FAA's Airport Improvement Program (AIP).

This is different from the City of San Jose's Local and Small Business Program

## ACDBE Plan Key Considerations

Demonstration of "Good Faith" efforts toward achievement of goals.

Annual reporting to the FAA by the Airports of participation by concession operators and the companies providing goods and services to the concessionaires.

# Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Certification



#### **ACDBE Eligibility Requirements**

Presumed Socially Disadvantaged – Women, Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, & Subcontinent Asian Americans, Other (as designated by Small Business Administration (SBA), or individual showing); refer to 49 CFR 26, Appendix E.

**Economically Disadvantaged** – **Effective May 9, 2024**, Personal Net Worth not exceeding **\$2.047 million** (adjusted from \$1.32 million), excluding retirement assets, equity in the primary residence and applicant business.

**Business Size Standards** – A firm (including affiliates) must be a small business as defined by SBA standards. For most types of businesses, gross receipts averaged over the previous 5 years must not exceed:

- **>** ACDBEs − **\$56.42 million**
- ➤ Car rental companies: \$75.23 million (Average annual gross receipts over the firm's five previous fiscal years).

Ownership & Control – The firm must be at least 51% owned and controlled by one or more socially and economically disadvantaged person(s), or, in the case of a corporation, in which 51% of the stock is owned by one or more such individual(s).

**Independence** – The 51% majority owner(s) must be free of any formal or informal restrictions that would affect their ability to own and/or control the firm.



#### **ACDBE Certification Application Processing**

- Uniform Certification Application: <a href="https://flysfo.gob2g.com/">https://flysfo.gob2g.com/</a>
- 2. Click the Apply for / Renew Certification button
  - Personal Net Worth Statement (PNW) must be notarized
- 3. Certification Specialist preliminary review: documentation
- 4. Within 30 days: notice if the application is complete and suitable for evaluation
- 5. In-person/virtual site visit
- 6. Certification decisions within 90 days
- 7. Certified firms will be added to the following directories:
  - 1. State database at <a href="https://californiaucp.dbesystem.com/">https://californiaucp.dbesystem.com/</a>
  - 2. Federal database at https://faa.dbesystem.com/Default.asp

- Federal Tax Returns Personal & Business (current 5 years)
- Professional Licenses
- Employee Data Verification
- Nationality and Gender Verification
- Proof of Ownership Contributions
- Place of Business Verification & List of Other Real Estate
- Articles of Incorporation/ Partnership Agreements
- Personal Net Worth Statement

#### Interstate Certification

- 1. Must be certified in the home state before seeking certification in another state.
- 2. Out-of-State Declaration: <a href="https://flysfo.gob2g.com/">https://flysfo.gob2g.com/</a>
- 3. Must submit a complete package of all the documents submitted to their home state
- 4. On-site report requests from the home state
- 5. Certification decision within 10 days (adjusted from 60 days; effective May 9, 2024)
